



Post Care for Pixel 8 Treatment

What to expect:

- Slight discomfort, redness, swelling and/or irritation after treatment is expected. If any discomfort persists more than 1-3 days, please call the office. (775) 525-1712
- To help with discomfort, you can apply a hydrocortisone cream 3-4 times per day to reduce redness. You can also apply an icepack (NOT directly to the skin) to the irritated area for approximately 15-minute sessions, 3-4 times per day.

What you need to do:

- Keep your skin moisturized after the treatment to help with discomfort.
- If you experience a burning sensation, you can spritz the treatment area with a diluted vinegar solution (1 tsp white vinegar per 1 cup water) to help neutralize any discomfort.
- Makeup can be applied 12 hours after treatment. An SPF 30 should be applied daily to protect your skin after your treatment.
- TWO DAYS after treatment: NO hot baths, massages, irritating skin care products or exfoliants, etc. The skin should be kept clean to avoid contamination or infection. Wash with water and mild soap.
- TWO WEEKS after treatment: NO prolonged sun exposure and tanning beds.

What you shouldn't do:

DO NOT PICK/SCRATCH at any small scabs that may appear 2-3 days post treatment. Allow them to shed naturally.

Things to look out for:

Any large amount of pain, swelling, or bruising is extremely rare. If you experience any of this, please call the office. (775) 525-1712
